## CHOLESTEROL MODULE

## DESCRIPTION

A powder containing cholesterol and carbohydrate.

## INDICATIONS

For use in the dietary management of medical conditions requiring a source of exogenous cholesterol e.g. Smith-Lemli Opitz Syndrome. Suitable for infants, children and adults.

## PREPARATION AND ADMINISTRATION

Intake should be based on serum levels of cholesterol and its metabolites. Most treatment protocols suggest a treatment dose of $100 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{kg} /$ day. Dissolve the prescribed amount of Cholesterol Module to form a paste and add to drink or meal. One scoop contains approximately 5.9 g of Cholesterol Module.

## ADMINISTRATION GUIDELINES

The dosage should be determined by a clinician or dietitian only and is dependent on the age, body weight and medical condition of the patient.

## GENERAL PRECAUTIONS

Use under medical supervision. Not for parenteral use.
Not suitable for use as a sole source of nutrition.

## STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place. Always replace the container lid after use. Once opened, use within one month. Once reconstituted, store in a refrigerator and consume within 24 hours. Stir or shake immediately before serving.
